Hensarling Statement on Passing of Rep. Henry Hyde

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Congressman Jeb Hensarling (R-TX), Chairman of the Republican Study Committee, offered condolences and prayers to the family of Rep. Henry Hyde after learning of his passing earlier this morning.
